In this connection, the applicant, who is now an Assistant Registrar in Admn. H-1 Section, puts before Your Lordship his humble submissions and replies to the abovenoted show cause notice dated 04.01.2011, which are given hereunder:

- (1) That the aboveresferred show cause notice relates to the matter causing an inordinate delay in dealing with the application dated- 10.11.2008 of Shri Avinash Mishra, Civil Judge ( Junior Division ) Allahabad. The said application was moved by Shri Mishra, as an information to this Hon'ble Court about the purchase of Hyundai Santro GLS Car ;
- (2) That it is a truth that abovenoted delay caused and occurred during the period, when applicant happened to be a Section Officer of Admn. H-1 Section, now promoted to the post of Assistant Registrar. But the applicant has requested to the higher

authorities for the provision/requisition of assistants in Admn-H-1 Section. Instead of repeated requests, no additional staff has been provided and the applicant was given an assurance by the authorities concerned that he may get required assistants after the process of new recruitment is being completed. Therefore, the applicant is facing an acute shortage of man-power. In view of the above facts and circumstances, a human error is perceptible and hence this incidence of inordinate delay occurred in processing the letter of Shri Avinash Mishra, for which applicant submits and seeks a personal apology to Your Lordship.

That it is worth to mention here that applicant's staff Shri Dhanraj Singh, Review Officer is looking after the work of two assistants. Due to shortage of space, files are piled up everywhere and it is difficult to move and work. Hence, by sheer inadvertance, the letter dated 10.11.2008 in question of MR. Avinash Mishra has been misplaced in some other file and remained unattended and unprocessed, for which the applicant seeks a pitiful apology to meet the ends of justice. Here the applicant understands

In this connection with the abovementioned Show Cause Notice dated 04.01.2011, the applicant MOST HUMBLY AND RESPECTFULLY submits his reply/ explanation for Your Lordship's kind perusal, ready reference and merciful sympathetic consideration please. The categorical reply/explanation to the abovenoted Show Cause Notice is being given hereunder in a paragraphical manner, i.e.

- (1) That the above referred Show Cause Notice pertains to the inordinate delay in dealing with the application dated 10.11.2008 of Shri Avinash Mishra, Civil Judge (Junior Division) Allahabad. The aforesaid application was meant for the post dated information about the purchase of Hyundai Santro GLS Car, by Shri Avinash Mishra, Civil Judge (Junior Division);
- (2) That it is true that letter dated 10.11.2008 has been processed by the applicant on dated 27.11.2010, for which the applicant has already put up his note on dated 27.11.2010. The applicant has submitted his note, showing his mistake, which was not an act of wilful omission or commission, but it happend inadvertantly, for which he seeks a merciful apology to My Lord. It is again reiterated that in future no such type of mistake shall be repeated and the applicant shall remain more careful and vigilant in future. (3) That in reply to paragraph no. 2 of the show cause notice it is to be stated that due to shortage of space, the aforesaid letter in reference has been misplaced. But the applicant is performing the work of two assistants, because two persons were looking the work of his seat, as no assistant is given in place of the promoted official.

(A) That the applicant is looking after the work relating to Misc. and Pension files of all Judicial Officers.

(B) That the applicant is looking after the work relating to the "Statement of movable & immovable properties given by all Judicial Officers", also.

That it was a human error, which occurred due to shortage of man power and staff, for which the applicant may kindly be apologised to meet the interest of justice and equity,

(5) That in reply to paragraph no. 4 of the abovenoted show cause notice, it is to be stated that it is expedient and therefore it is MOST HUMBLY AND RESPECTFULLY requested to Your Lordship that My Lord may kindly and graciously be pleased to pass an order by apolising the applicant mercifully and applicant hopes that in view of above facts and circumstances, My Lord shall
