May kindly see the application, placed below at flag 'A' & 'A-1', received from Smt. Aparna Pandey, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Lucknow, by which she has requested the Court to issue 'No Objection Certificate' in her favour for obtaining Passport.

In her letters, Smt. Aparna Pandey has stated that, she may have to go for a foreign visit in near future and therefore, she wants to apply for obtaining Passport in her favour, that there is no possibility of arising any embarrassing position to Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to her foreign visit, that her request to issue 'No-objection Certificate' for obtaining a Passport is not refused earlier, that she has not visited any foreign country earlier. She has also submitted her three photographs and stated that Km. Vidushi Pandey (daughter) and Master Aviral Shanker Pandey (son) are dependent family members of her. She has, therefore, requested that her request may kindly be placed before the Court for issuance of 'No-objection Certificate' in her favour for obtaining Passport.

In this connection, it is submitted that 'No-objection Certificate' (now said as 'Identity Certificate' as per new proforma issued by the Passport department) for obtaining a Passport may be issued to the officers in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). It is further submitted that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance / departmental enquiry is pending against Smt. Aparna Pandey. She may be granted 'No-objection Certificate' / 'Identity Certificate' from this Court, as requested.

'A' May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Karuna Kant Misra, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship, the 'Identity Certificate' at flag 'C' be issued, in duplicate, in favour of Smt. Aparna Pandey, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Lucknow for obtaining Passport with the direction that she should take prior permission of the Court before proceeding abroad?
