

May kindly see the letter at flag A', received from Smt. Aparna Pandey, Secretary, Uttarakhand Human Rights Commission, Dehradun (on deputation) regarding issuance of 'Identity Certificate' in her favour for issuance/ renewal of Passport.

In her letter, Smt. Aparna has stated that the validity period of her passport no. H 0872167 is going to be expired on 23.09.2018. Therefore she wants to renew her passport, for which fresh 'No Objection/ Identity Certificate' is required. Ms. Vidushi Pandey (Daughter) and Master Aviral Shankar Pandey (Son) are the dependent family members of the officer. She has also enclosed four passport size photographs of herself and required details/ declaration on 'Affidavit', which may kindly be seen at flag 'B'. She has, therefore, requested to the Court for issuance of 'Identity Certificate' in her favour for issuance/ renewal of Passport.

In this connection, it is submitted that issuance of 'No Objection Certificate' i.e. 'Identity Certificate' on new proforma for obtaining Passport is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'C'). Earlier, the officer appears to have obtained Passport (copy at flag 'D') after taking 'Identity Certificate' from this Court (as per approval of the then Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Lucknow dated 29.08.2008 at flag 'X'). Here, it is also to submit that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance/ departmental enquiry is pending against Smt. Aparna Pandey. Now, as the officer wants to renew her earlier issued passport, which is going to be expired on 23.09.2018, her request appears to be considerable, as she has submitted required details and papers in this connection. It is also required to be mentioned here that normally such type of matter is submitted to Hon'ble the Administrative Judge of the district concerned, but as in the instant case, the officer who is an officer of this State's judiciary, posted on deputation outside the state, her file is likely to be placed before Hon'ble The Chief Justice

Under the facts and circumstances mentioned above, if approved, the file may be laid before Hon'ble The Chief Justice for kind perusal and if His Lordship approves, the 'Identity Certificate' at flag '#' be issued, in duplicate, in favour of Smt. Aparna Pandey, Secretary, Uttarakhand Human
