- that the presence of the applicant outside India may not, or is not likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
- that the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, not being convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years;
- that proceedings in respect of any offence alleged to have not been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India;
- (g) that a warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has not been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has not been made by any such court;

(h) that the applicant has not been repatriated.
