

May kindly see the letters, placed below at flag 'A', A-1' & 'A-2', received from Sri Shakti Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hardoi, regarding grant of permission to purchase a Revolver from Indian Ordinance Factory, Kanpur.

In his letter at flag 'A', Sri Singh has stated that he has submitted application for issuance of License for firearm and is pending there. As per Court's Circular latter 11/ IV h-16/ Admin(A)/ dated 12.04.2010 and 25/ Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998, he has to take prior permission to purchase Firearm. He has, therefore, requested the Court to grant him permission to purchase a Revolver, giving the required details in his letter at flag 'A-1' & 'A-2'.

The information regarding transaction of the Revolver, as required under Courts Circular Letter No. 25/ Admin (A) dated 13.07.1998 as furnished by the officer is given below: -

It is submitted that as per Rule- 24 (2) of U.P. Government Servant's conduct (Amendment) Rule, (2) -

"A Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding in value, the amount of his basic pay for one month, whether by way of purchase, sale or otherwise, shall forthwith report such transaction to the appropriate authority:

Provided that no Government servant shall inter into any such transaction except with or through a reputed dealer or agent of standing, or with the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."

The only reason assigned in his letter by the officer for having a revolver is for self defence/protection. The term "self-defence/protection" is a vague term and should be propped up by explicit details.

In the light of the A.C resolution and regard being had to the consideration which weighed up with the court in passing the resolution, specific query should made from the officer whether he or any of his family members is in possession of any fire arm and whether the need to possess further weapon is fueled by any threat perception.

The file be put up after the reply to query aforesaid is received.
