

May kindly see the letter dated 01.09.2010, placed below at flag 'I', received from Sri Shakti Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hardoi, by which he has submitted reply about grant of permission to purchase a Revolver.

In this connection, it is submitted that earlier, Sri Shakti Singh had applied for grant of permission to purchase a Revolver from Indian Ordinance Factory, Kanpur through his letters at flags 'A', 'A-1' & 'A-2' and accordingly an office note dated 30.07.2010 (flag 'II') was put up before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Imtiyaz Murtaza. His Lordship then pleased to pass an order dated 09.08.2010, as reproduced below:

"The only reason assigned in his letter by the officer for having a revolver is for self defence/ protection. The term "self- defence/ protection" is a vague term and should be propped up by explicit details.

In the light of the A.C. Resolution and regard being had to the consideration which weighed up with the Court in passing the resolution, specific query should be made from the officer whether he or any of his family members is in possession of any fire arm and whether the need to possess further weapon is fueled by any threat perception.

The file be put after the reply to query aforesaid is received."

In compliance of the order, a Court's letter dated 18.08.2010 (flag 'III') was sent to the District Judge, Hardoi making the required query from the officer.

Now, in reply of the Court's letter dated 18.08.2010, Sri Shakti Singh has stated that there is no fire arm in his name or in the name of any of his family member. Regarding any threat perception, he has stated that till now during his service, he has passed adverse judicial orders against several influential persons. During his posting at Ambedkarnagar, he had passed adverse judicial orders against the local M.P.. During his posting at Hardoi, he had passed arrest order against a Minister of State. Apart from this, several orders were passed against Police officers & employees, who have failed to do their official obligation. Possibly, due to these type of orders, he was threatened on phone in December 2009, intimation of which was given to the Police Superintendent, Hardoi. Under the situation, he is circumstantially forced to surrender his L.I.C. Policy to purchase a fire arm and need arises to purchase a fire arm for the security of himself and his family. He has, finally, submitted that this representation may kindly be submitted before the Hon'ble Court for kind consideration.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Imtiyaz Murtaza for His Lordship's kind perusal & for passing appropriate orders as deem fit
