May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A' received from Sri Nitendra Kumar, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Agra regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial year 2014-15 and 2015-16 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial year 2014-15, income from salary is Rs.12,21,365/- and from this amount, Rs.4,800/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.1,50,805/- against Income Tax, Rs.71,732/- against NPS, Rs.94,063/- against premium of LIC policies, Rs.60,000/- against Mutual fund and Rs.3,00,000/- deposited in his PPF accounts. The balance of his savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.2,66,589/- this financial year from previous year's balance. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.9,47,989/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.2,73,376/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

(2) In the financial year 2015-16, income from salary is Rs.11,23,356/- and from this amount, Rs.4,800/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.1,50,805/- against Income Tax, Rs.71,732/- against NPS, Rs.94,063/- against premium of LIC policies, Rs.60,000/- against Mutual fund and Rs.3,00,000/- deposited in his PPF accounts. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.6,81,400/-. The balance of his savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.87,398/- this financial year from previous year's balance. Thus, a sum of Rs.5,29,354/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

In this connection it is submitted that Sri Nitendra Kumar has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2013-14 (statement is at

flag 'M') which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rakesh Srivastava, the then Administrative Judge, Sonbhadra at flag 'Z'.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial year 2014-15 & 2015-16 in its next financial year i.e., in 2016-17 up to March 2017. He has submitted the movable and immovable property statement for the financial year 2014-15 & 2015-16 vide his letter dated 07.12.2017 (at flag 'A'). As such, there is delay in submitting the property statements for the aforesaid financial years from the part of the officer for which he has regretted to say that the same could not be submitted within due time inadvertently and requested to kindly condone the delay & accept the statements.

May, therefore, if approved, the property statements for the financial years 2014-15 and 2015-16 alongwith letter dated 07.12.2017 (at flag 'A') of Sri Nitendra Kumar, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Agra be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manoj Misra, Administrative Judge, Agra Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
