May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A', received from Sri Santosh Kumar-II, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barabanki regarding submission of statement of movable property exceeding to value of one month's basic pay and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable property for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial year 2010-11, the income from salary is Rs.9,83,008/- and from this amount, Rs.1,440/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.1,10,554/- against CPF, Rs.1,03,383/- against Income Tax, Rs.1,87,200/- against NSC, Rs.85,440/- against Car loan and Rs.10,000/- deposited in his PPF account. The balance of his savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.47,763/- this financial year. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.5,45,780/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.4,37,228/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that his wife is Jr. Clerk Commercial Tax Deptt. U.P. and her income is Rs.1,80,000/-per annum(approx.).

(2) In the financial year 2011-12, the income from salary is Rs.9,91,121/- and from this amount, Rs.2,160/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.78,205/- against CPF, Rs.85,780/- against Income Tax, Rs.16,200/- against NSC, Rs.56,960/- against Car loan and Rs.17,356/- (including interest) deposited in his PPF account. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.2,56,661/-. The balance of his savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.58,840/- this financial year. Thus, a sum of Rs.7,93,300/- was

therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

His wife's income is Rs.2,00,000/- per annum (approx.).

(3) In the financial year 2012-13, the income from salary is Rs.8,44,972/- and from this amount, Rs.4,600/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.6,808/- against CPF, Rs.50,699/- against Income Tax and Rs.22,554/- (including interest) deposited in his PPF account. The balance of his savings bank account(s) enhanced for Rs.1,03,078/- this financial year. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.1,87,739/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.6,57,233/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

His wife's income is Rs.2,40,000/- per annum (approx.).

(4) In the financial year 2013-14, the income from salary is Rs.8,52,401/- and from this amount, Rs.4,800/- is deducted against GIS, Rs.75,358/- against Income Tax and Rs.20,000/- (including interest) deposited in his PPF account. As such, total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment is Rs.1,00,158/-. The balance of his savings bank account(s) reduced for Rs.94,327/- this financial year. Thus, a sum of Rs.8,46,570/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in whole of the financial year.

His wife's income is Rs.2,82,000/- per annum (approx.).

In this connection it is submitted that Sri Santosh Kumar-II has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2009-10 (statement is at flag 'M') which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ashwani Kumar Singh, the then Administrative Judge, Ambedkar Nagar on 02.02.2011 at flag 'Z'.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement ~~at the time of entering into Judicial service after joining into Judicial service and~~ for the financial year 2010-11 & 2011-12 in its next financial year i.e., 2012-13 upto march 2013 and 2012-13 & 2013-14 in its next

financial year i.e., 2014-15 upto March 2015. He has submitted the movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-2014 vide his letter dated 28.03.2016 (at flag 'A'). As such, there is delay in submitting the property statements for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 from the part of the officer for which he has regretted for late submission of property statements and stated that in future, he will submit property statement within due time in his letter dated 28.03.2016 (at flag 'A').

May, therefore, if approved, the property statements for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 alongwith letter dated 28.03.2016 (at flag 'A') of Sri Santosh Kumar-II, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barabanki before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pankaj Mithal, Administrative Judge, Barabanki Judgship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
