On the forwarding note dated 08.02.2012 (flag '3') of Ld. Registrar (B), His Lordship had been pleased to order on 14.02.2012 that Whether permission was taken for taking loan from brother & source of the loan amount. Obtain reply of the officer.

The order was communicated vide Court's letter dated 02.03.2012 (flag '4'). The officer has been asked to comply with the Court's order, vide letter dated 02.03.2012.

In reply of the Court's letter dated 02.03.2012, Sri Abhay Prakash Narain, vide his letter dated 19.07.2012 at flag '2A', has submitted that he was under impression that, for acceptance of loan from his real elder brother no previous permission is required. As far as the source of income of his elder brother Sri Vinay Prakash Narain is in question, his elder brother Sri Vinay Prakash Narain is in judicial service since 1986 and has been deputed in the office of District Development Officer, Balia as Senior Assistant. This is his first bona fide mistake and so he hereby tender an unconditional apology for the mistake committed by him in this regard. He also prey for the kind consideration of Hon'ble High Court for acceptance of his apology and forgiving him in this regard.

In this connection, the relevant extract of rule relating to Lending and Borrowing (Rule 22 of the U.P. Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1956) is as under :-

22. Lending and Borrowing:- A government servant may accept a purely temporary loan amount exceeding in value the amount of his two months' basic pay free of interest, from a personal friend or relative or operate a credit account with a bona fide tradesman.

May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A' & 'A-1', received from Sri Abhay Prakash Narain, Judicial Magistrate, Faizabad regarding permission to sell a parental immovable property i.e. his 1/3rd share measuring 1.9466 Hectare, out of land Gata no.-420, measuring 5.8400 Hectare, situated at Village- Fulsungi, Tehsil- Kichcha, District-Udham Singh Nagar, Rudrapur (Uttarakhand).

In his letters, Sri Abhay Prakash Narain has stated that he wants to sell his 1/3rd share in his parental immovable property measuring 1.9466 Hectare, out of land Gata no.- 420, measuring 5.8400 Hectare, situated at Village- Fulsungi, Tehsil- Kichcha, District- Udham Singh Nagar, Rudrapur (Uttarakhand), due to his personal financial needs. The property is to be sold to one Sri Jagdish Singh, S/o Sri Ram Singh Bisht, R/o House no. 28, Model Colony, Rudrapur, District- Udham Singh Nagar (Uttarakhand) @ Rs. 35,00,000/per Hectare i.e. for a total sum of about Rs. 68,13,100/-. He has also submitted that the proposed purchaser is not related to him in any way and no case of the purchaser is ever pending in or decided in his court. He has, therefore, requested for grant of permission to sell the property.

Provided that any such transaction conducted otherwise than through a regular & reputed dealer shall require the previous sanction of the appropriate authority."
