May kindly see the letters at flags 'A', received from Sri Manoj Kumar-I, Special Judicial Magistrate, Pollution/CBI, Lucknow regarding grant of permission to visit United Kingdom in the month of June 2015.

In his letter, Sri Manoj Kumar has stated that his relative namely S.Tejwant resides abroad at 83,Lea Road, Pennfields Wolverhampton, Post Code-WV3-OLN (U.K.) and he is inviting him repeatedly to visit his place. He himself has valid passport (copy is at flag 'X'), which he obtained with due permission of the Hon'ble Court, and intend to proceed to U.K. Visiting at above mentioned place by utilising the recess period in June 2015 positively from 13.06.2015 to 24.06.2015. He has also submitted that:-

- 1. There will be no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to his proposed visit to U.K..
- 2. Such type of request was ever refused to him earlier.
- 3. he has not visited any foreign country earlier.
- **4.** The expenditure of his visit will be around Rs. 90,000 Rs. 1,00,000 only, which will be borne from his as well as his wife's S.B. A/c no. 6177000400000762, 6177000400000771 (PNB) respectively (copies are at flags 'Y' & 'Y-1'). His wife is also posted as Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Lucknow

He has, therefore, requested that the matter regarding grant of permission to visit U.K. in the month of June 2015 for about ten days, may kindly be placed before the Hon'ble Court for kind consideration..

In this connection, it is submitted that grant of permission to visit abroad is considered in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'C'). As per reports, placed below, no vigilance/departmental enquiry is pending against Sri Manoj Kumar-I. He has also submitted required details and declarations as prescribed in the G.O. Dated 14.06.1999. Now, as he has requested to grant him permission to visit U.K. to see his relative there, his request may be considered as per discretion of the Court.
