Chitrakoot Judgeship, the 'No Objection Certificate' at flag 'C' be issued, in favour of Sri Shailender Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division)/ Judicial Magistrate, Mau (Chitrakoot), for obtaining Passport with the direction that he should take prior permission of the Court before
