May Kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A', received from Sri Shailender Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Meerut regarding grant of permission to do LL.M/ course (Distant Education) from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana.

In his letter, Sri Singh has stated that, he has got keen interest in higher studies and want to do LL.M. course (Distant Education) from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana as there is no classes as continuing his course from there. He also gives assurance that his higher studies of LL.M. will not hamper judicial work in any way. He has, therefore, requested that his request may kindly be considered, so that he may take admission in 2008-09 session.

In this connection, it is submitted that a judicial officer can be accorded permission to attend academic classes and specialized higher studies in terms of G.O.No. 24/1066-Appointment (B) dated 21.08.1967 (copy at flag X), subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) Government work should not suffer in any way.
- The academic classes are held outside office hours. (2)
- No preferential treatment will be given in the matter of leave, postings and (3)transfer.
- The permission can be withdrawn without notice if, it is found at any time that the (4) government servant neglects his normal work or that public work suffers, in any way.

In the instant case, it is to mention that the officer has joined the judicial service on 16.06.2006. As the course, which he want(to do, is through correspondence, there seems to be nothing objectionable, if he will be granted the permission, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above. However, acceptance of his request is on the discretion of the Court.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble The Chief Justice, permission be accorded to Sri Shailender Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Meerut to do LL.M. (Correspondence course) from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana, as requested, subject to the conditions mentioned above?
