May kindly see the letter of Sri Shailendra Singh, Civil Judge (S.D.), Auraiya bearing endorsement No. 441/I dated 29.04.2016 of District Judge, Auraiya placed below at Flag A regarding Ex-post-facto permission with reference to information to the Head of Office regarding commencement of the treatment of his son in private hospital, for the period of treatment from 12.06.2015 to 15.02.2016 within 30 days from date of start of treatment, which is not complied with.

Through aforesaid endorsement dated 29.04.2016 Sri Singh is seeking Ex-post-facto permission with regard to commencement of treatment of his son in private hospital i.e. The Child Centre, Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi which was not sought in time due to unawareness of the provisions contained in "The Uttar Pradesh Government Servants (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2011" read with "The Uttar Pradesh Government Servants (Medical Attendance) (First Amendment) Rules, 2014".

X It is pertinent to mention here that there is no provision of Ex-post-facto permission in "The Uttar Pradesh Government Servants (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2011" read with "The Uttar Pradesh Government Servants (Medical Attendance) (First Amendment) Rules, 2014" but mentioning the reason, under rule 28(b), Sri Singh needs to submit an application alongwith the original medical reimbursement claim seeking relaxation of the same.

A In the facts and circumstances mentioned above, may if deemed fit and proper, the file may kindly be laid before the Registrar (Judicial)(Budget) for kind perusal and orders to the effect that the information above at 'X' may be sent to District Judge, Auraiya with the request to kindly inform the same to Sri Shailendra Singh, Civil Judge (S.D.), Auraiya accordingly?
