May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'I', received from the District Judge, Meerut, regarding submission of his opinion about submission of explanation by Sri Shailendra Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Meerut in connection with purchase of a car by him.

In this connection, it is submitted that earlier in the matter of submission of information about purchase of a new Hyundai i-10 car by Sri Shailendra Singh, Judicial Magistrate, Meerut, Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza, vide his Lordship's order dated 21.05.2008 (flagged 'O'), queried as to how the officer proposes to make both ends meet with the amount that survives with him after repaying Rs.6492/- as repayment of car loan from his take home salary of Rs. 19885/-. The order was communicated vide Court's letter dated 31.05.2008 and after receiving reply of the Court's letter dated 31.05.2008 through his letter dated 23.06.2008 (flagged 'X'), an office note dated 08.08.2008 (flagged, 'II') was again submitted before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza, whereupon His Lordship ahs been pleased to pass order on 21.08 2008 (flagged in) to relegate the matter to the District Judge concerned where the officer is posted with the request to append his opinion about the authenticity/ plausibility of the explanation submitted by the officer attended with his view whether the officer can manage the affairs within the diminished amount that survives with him consistent with dignity of a judicial officer. The said order of His Lordship was communicated to the District Judge, Meerut for submission of his opinion vide Court's latter dated 10.09.2008.

Now, in reply of the Court's letter dated 10.09.2008, the District Judge, Meerut, vide his letter dated 22.09.2008 at flag 'land has submitted his opinion in the matter and has stated that the monthly pay of the officer is Rs.20,815/- and he is withdrawing Rs. 20,195/- per month after deduction. The officer alongwith his wife and one daughter of about one year old is living in the government residence, allotted to him and after deduction of amount of car loan instalment of Rs. 6,492/- from his take home salary, an amount comes to Rs. 13,703/-. As per his opinion, a Civil Judge (Jr. Div.) can manage the affairs within the diminished amount of Rs. 13,703/- and can lead his life with dignity.

May, therefore, if approved, the file be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice M.I. Murtaza for His Lordship kind perusal and further orders in the matter?
