

May kindly see the letter, placed below at flag 'A' & 'A-1', received from Smt. Rekha Singh, Addl. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Agra, by which she has requested the Court to issue 'No Objection Certificate' in her favour for obtaining Passport.

In her letters, Smt. Rekha Singh has stated that, her brother's wife is suffering major illness from Kidney desease and there will be a possibility of foreign visit in connection with her treatment. In the circumstance, she is willing to obtain Passport for her foreign visit, for which 'No-objection Certificate' from the Hon'ble Court is required. She has also submitted that, there will be no possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to her visit to a foreign country and that she has not visited any foreign country earlier. She has also submitted her three photographs. Her dependant are Master Abhishek Kumar (son) & Km. Akansha (daughter). She has, therefore, requested for issuance of 'No-objection Certificate'/ 'Identity Certificate' in her favour for obtaining Passport.

In this connection, it is submitted that 'No-objection Certificate' (now said as 'Identity Certificate' as per new proforma issued by the Passport department) for obtaining a Passport may be issued to the officers in accordance to the G.O.1/3/98-Ka-Prasko/1999 dated 14 June 1999 (flagged 'B'). It is further submitted that as per reports, placed below, no vigilance / departmental enquiry is pending against Smt. Rekha Singh. She may be issued 'No-objection Certificate' / 'Identity Certificate' for obtaining Passport, as requested.

May, therefore, if approved by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sunil Ambwani, Administrative Judge, Agra Judgeship, the 'Identity Certificate' at flag 'C' be issued, in duplicate, in favour of Smt. Rekha Singh, Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Agra for obtaining Passport with the direction that she should take prior permission of the Court before proceeding abroad?
