- Estimated expenditure of the visit on tickets, fooding, lodging etc. and as to how she 2. bear the same?
- 3. Whether there is any possibility of arising any embarrassing position before the Government of India or the Government of U.P. due to her visit to the foreign country?
- Whether such type of request was ever refused to her? 4.
- Details of her earlier foreign visit(s), as she had been permitted to visit Mauritius from 5. 21.06.2010 to 10.07.2010, vide this Court's letter no. 9573/ IV-3468/ Admin(A)/ Dated 11.06.2010.

The details of points no. 1 & 2 are required in general just to know the full details of the proposed visit. The details of points no. 3, 4 & 5 are required under the provisions of G.O. no. 1/3/98- Ka. Prasko./ 1999 dated 14.06.1999, placed at flag 'X'.

May, therefore, if approved by the Learned Registrar General, such details/ information/

declaration be asked from the officer by sending a letter through fax/ speed post? May kindly peruse the above office note, and may like to lay the file before Learned Registrar General for kind perusal and Roghton General J.R. (M) 10/8/2010
