

In the matter of issuing "no objection certificates" or "identity certificates" to officers applying for obtaining passport, the Registrar (Budget) was directed to inform the present practice in this regard.

The Registrar (Budget) vide his note dated 09.05.2011 has informed that on query made by the Hon'ble Administrative Judge Jaunpur/Varanasi, after examining the matter, the proposal for issuance of 'no objection certificate' was made which was approved by the Hon'ble Administrative Judges before whom such note was placed and the present practice is of issuing "no objection certificate" It is further informed that there is no authorization/order as to by whom such certificate is to be issued, but as per past practice, such certificates are being issued by the Registrar Budget.

In view of the note of the Registrar Budget, proposal for issuing "no objection certificate" to the officer by the Registrar Budget is approved subject to furnishing the following information by the officer, if not already furnished.

- 1. In case he is granted permission for going abroad, will there be any possibility for creating anomalous position to the State/Central Government.
- 2. Whether such type of request was ever refused to him?
- 3. Whether he has visited any foreign country till now, and if yes, to give details thereof?
- 4. An undertaking that he will not engage, directly or indirectly, in any trade business or any employment in foreign country and will join his duties after expiry of leave period.
- 5. An undertaking to disclose the purpose and source of expenses to be incurred.
- 6. Any other information/formality as would appear necessary.
