Amsterdam & Paris to be held between 13th July-
19th July, 2014 excluding the journey period.**

The main theme of Power Market Study Tour is the global challenge of transforming the existing energy network to enable the maximum renewable energy in future.

The Indian Energy Exchange is the India's No.1 Power Exchange. IEE has been established with the objective of promotion of renewable sources of energy. Its main activities are :

- a) renewable energy related scientific research, technical developments, monitor applications, support and guidance;
- b) to collect and discriminate information in the field of renewable energy sources;
- c) to conduct Conferences, seminars and other events to promote renewable sources of energy.
- d) Providing a transparent, neutral, demutualized and automated platform for physical delivery of electricity, IEX enables efficient price discovery and price risk management for participants of the electricity market.
- e) Launched in February 2011, Renewable Energy Certificate market facilitates transaction in green attributes. The Renewable Energy (RE) generator can opt to get RECs against green attributes of their generation. These generators can sell RECs through the exchange. On the other hand, the obligatd entities-distribution companies, captive plants and open access consumers may opt to

purchase RECs to fulfill their Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO). The corporate, event organizers may also procure these RECs to compensate their conventional energy consumption into carbon free green consumption. The REC Market offers both solar and non-solar RECs.

- f) ESCerts will be the tradable certificates under the Perform, Achieve, Trade (PAT) Scheme of Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), a market-based mechanism to incentivise energy efficiency in large energy-intensive industries. IEX is all set to soon launch Energy Saving Certificates (ESCert), in its endeavor to expand the energy markets in India.

- is dedicated to the cause of completely towards the market strategies, policy framework and research & development.

The Registration fee for one participant is Rs.3.50/- lakhs + service tax **excluding travel charges, daily meal** and the other expenses are included in the Registration fee e.g. local transportation, recommendations etc., thus the expenditure would be sufficient for two members as the same exist in the budget for participation in international conference. The expenditure for participation of two persons would be well within this allocation.
