He has submitted the same through letter dated 11-12-2013 and as such, there ^{is} delay in submitting the said statements.

May kindly see the letter dtd. 10.10.2014 (flagged 'A'), received from Sri Anil Kumar Verma, Special Judge (E.C. Act)/Additional District & Sessions Judge, Shahjahanpur regarding grant of permission for the purchase of rifle.

In this letter, Sri Verma has requested for seeking permission regarding purchase of a Rifle and a Pistol for the purpose of his personal security and confidence through his letter dtd. 25.09.2010 (flagged 'X'), upon which the Hon'ble Court has asked him vide letter no. 10554/IV-3539/Admin (A)/dated 18.06.2011 (flagged 'X-1') for making one choice, either a Rifle or a Pistol. In compliance of the aforesaid letter, he has submitted his choice for purchasing a Pistol. The Hon'ble Court had granted him permission for the purchase of a Pistol vide letter no. 12947/IV-3539/Admin (A) dated 10.08.2011 (flagged 'Y') and he had purchased the same and submitted all the requisite details to the Hon'ble Court. The officer had obtained license of a Rifle as well as Pistol, hence a request was made for seeking permission for the purchase of a Rifle vide letter no. 119/I dated 31.01.2012 (flagged 'Y-1'). It is relevant to mention that in pursuance to the Hon'ble Court's letter no. 4052/IV-3539/Admin 'A' dated 22.03.2012 (flagged 'Z'), he has submitted the desired information including the price, make, model alongwith the name and address of the dealer vide letter no. 267/I Admin dated 30.03.2012 (flagged 'Z-1'). The Hon'ble Court had rejected his request for the purchase of a Rifle vide letter no. 8827/IV-3539/Admin (A) dated 02.06.2012 (flagged 'Z-2'). He has, therefore, requested to place these facts for grant of permission to purchase Rifle before the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that according to this Court's C.L. no. 11/ IVh-16/ Admin (A) dated 12.04.2010 (copy at flag 'B'), the officer is required to take permission of this Court to purchase a firearm, for which he has requested. Earlier, vide Court's order dated 31.05.2011 (flagged 'Z-3'), he was asked to make a choice either for rifle or a pistol and by choosing for purchase of a pistol, vide Court's order dated 28.07.2011 (flagged 'Z-4'), he was permitted to purchase a pistol. Thereafter vide Court's order dtd. 25.05.2012 (flagged 'Z-5') his application for grant of permission for purchase of a Rifle also, was rejected. In compliance of the aforesaid letter, he has submitted his choice for purchasing a Pistol.
