May kindly see the property statement submitted online dated 08.06.2020 received from Smt. Shuchi Srivastava, Registrar (J) (Enquiry), Allahabad regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18, income from salary is Rs.30,50,059/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investments (for both the financial years) against GIS, GPF, Income Tax, Home loan, PPF, LIC and the balance of her savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.4,84,042/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.21,98,138/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.8,51,921/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting three members in both the financial years.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband is Medical Officer, P.M.S., High Court Dispensary, Allahabad having annual income of Rs.75,000/- per month.

In this connection, it is submitted that Smt. Shuchi Srivastava has already submitted her property statement upto the financial years 2015-16 which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Bala Krishna Narayana, the then Administrative Judge, Allahabad in the misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statements of the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide online dated 08.06.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which she is seeking apology and stated that due to excessive work load, she could not submit property statements within time in her reply dated 06.07.2020.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Smt. Shuchi Srivastava, Registrar (J) (Enquiry), Allahabad be laid before Hon'ble the Chief Justice for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
