May kindly see the property statement submitted online dated 20.10.2020 received from Sri Ajay Kumar Singh-II, Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19, income from salary (of both the financial years) are Rs.30,83,082/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, GPF, Income Tax, Car loan, PPF, Sukanya Samridhi Yojna, SIP and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.3,28,824/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.22,56,248/-. Thus, a sum of Rs. 8,26,834/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting five members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement up to the financial years 2014-15 which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow in the misc. file of the officer. And of the financial years 2015-16 & 2016-17, a separate note has been made on case-id no.1068.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 in its next financial year i.e., 2019-20 up to March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 vide online dated 20.10.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the

part of the officer for which he has regretted in his letter dated 17.10.2020 (attached 'letter' with the statement)

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19 of Sri Ajay Kumar Singh-II, Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
