May kindly see the property statements submitted online dated 25.08.2020 received from Sri Jai Prakash Singh-II, Principal Secretary(Law) & L.R., Govt. of U.P., Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18, total income is Rs.37,03,918/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, GPF, Income Tax, LIC policies and Home loan are Rs.23,73,583/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.13,30,335/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting five members in both the financial years. And the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also reduced for Rs.3,63,105/- this financial year from previous year's balance.

It is pertinent to mention here that his wife earns income of Rs.50,000/- per month from Agriculture.

In this connection it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2015-16 which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice D.K.Arora, the then Administrative Judge, Mathura in the misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto march 2019. He has submitted property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide online dated 25.08.2020, As such, there is

delay in submitting the aforesaid property statement from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Sri Jai Prakash Singh-II, Principal Secretary(Law) & L.R., Govt. of U.P., Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
