May kindly see the property statement submitted online dated 20.10.2020 received from Sri Sanjay Kumar-V, Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19, Total Gross income from salary is Rs.31,06,600/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, Income Tax, CPF, RD, LIC,PLI,SIP, PPF and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.10,89,655/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.24,72,707/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.6,33,893/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years.

It is pertinent to mention here that his wife is Judicial Magistrate, having annual income of Rs.8,31,164/- and Rs.10,62,745/- in the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 respectively.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements upto the financial year 2016-17 which has already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow in the misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 in its next financial year i.e., 2019-20 up to March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2017-18 firstly vide offline letter dated 31.10.2018 (in the misc. file of the officer) & 2018-19 vide online dated 07.09.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the property statement of the financial year 2018-19 from the part of the officer of which no explanation has been submitted by the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19 of Sri Sanjay Kumar-V, Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
