May kindly see the online letter 18.02.2020 received from Sri Gyanendra Kumar, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Bareilly regarding submission of statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 on proper proforma to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 of the Officer concerned, details of income, deductions, savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

1. In the financial years 2016-17 (10.02.2017 to 31.03.2017) and 2017-18, his gross income from salary is Rs. 9,10,702/- and total deductions/Savings/investments against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, PPF and LIC is Rs.1,93,845/-. Thus a sum of Rs. 7,16,857/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of two members in the financial years 2016-17 and 2017- 18. The balance of Rs. 14,230/- has decreased from his saving bank A/c against the balance of the previous year.

It is pertinent to mention that the wife of the officer, Dr. Jyoti Gautam is a PCS, whose annual income is Rs. 7,10,000/-

For the preceding financial year, the officer has submitted his property statements held at the time entering Judicial Services which has been processed presently online and separate office note has already been submitted for orders on separate case id no. 731.

The movable and immovable property statement for the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18 have been submitted by the Officer vide his online case id no. 732 dated 18.02.2020 which were due to be submitted upto the end of the financial year 2018-19. As such, there is delay in submitting the property statements from the part of the officer and he has apologised for the delay caused.
