May kindly see the property statement submitted online dated 19.03.2020 received from Sri Chandragupta, Additional District & Sessions Judge (POCSO), Sitapur regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19, Gross income from salary (of both the financial years) is Rs.39,32,464/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, Income Tax, NPS, LIC policies,RD, Car loan, Car Refinance loan, PPF a/c and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.84,984/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.18,34,982/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.20,97,482/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements upto the financial years 2016-17, which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abhinava Upadhya, the then Administrative Judge, Ghazipur with the order issued to the "officer must be prompt in future".

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 in its next financial year i.e., 2019-20 upto March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2017-18 & 2018-19 vide online dated 19.03.2020. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2017-18 & 2018-19 of Sri Chandragupta, Additional District & Sessions Judge(POCSO), Sitapur be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pankaj Naqvi, Administrative Judge, Sitapur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
