With reference to letter no. 17/ XV dated 08-01-2016 on the above subject, I have to say that in the statement of movable and immovable property for the financial Year 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 submitted by Sri Aditya Chaturvedi, Civil Judge (Sr. Div.), Chandauli has mentioned that his gross salary in the financial year 2010-11 is Rs.04,81,760/and Rs.9,492/- from interest from his saving account. He has deposited as enhanced amount ofRs.3,78,857/- (including interest) in SB accounts from previous years balance,, Rs.19,685/deducted from salary as Income Tax, Rs.660/- as GIS, Rs.4,764/- deposited as LIC, Rs.70,000/- deposited in PPF account. His total deduction/ investment from income comes to Rs.04,90,894/-. Thus, it is not clear how he managed his family in the financial year 2010-11.

I am therefore to request you that Sri Aditya chaturvedi may kindly be asked to clarify the actual position about the point raised with supporting papers to the Court immediately so that further necessary action may be taken in the matter.

I am further to sat that Sri Chaturvedi may also be asked to furnish the details of deductions of NPS in the financial years 2012-13 and 2013-14, to disclose the details information as required in column no. 4 i. e. details of movable property purchase up to the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14, and to furnish cogent and concrete reasons for not submitting property statements for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14, within due time.
