May kindly see the online property statements received from Sri Pradeep Kumar-V, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sambhal regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23, Total gross salary is Rs.55,60,871/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, NPS, Income Tax and PPF a/c are Rs.17,98,921/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.37,61,950/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years. And the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also reduced for Rs.19,86,367/- in this financial year from previous year's balance.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements of the financial years 2019-21 online which had already been seen online by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rohit Ranjan Agarwal, the then Administrative Judge, Gautambuddha Nagar.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 in its next financial year i.e., 2023-24 upto March 2024. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 firstly vide online dated 02.03.2024. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23 of Sri Pradeep Kumar-V, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sambhal be laid before Hon'ble Justice Renu Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Sambhal Judgeship for Her Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
