In this connection, it is submitted that as per statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) of the officer, concerned, details of income, deductions, savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) firstly vide his application dated 02.07.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which he deeply regrets the delay and prays for condonation.
