May kindly see the reply submitted online dated 17.02.2022 received from Smt. Anita Singh, Civil Judge (Senior Division)/ F.T.C. Raebareli, in compliance of order of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Raebareli in the matter of property statement, communicated to the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that earlier the officer had submitted her movable & immovable property statements at the time of entering into Judicial Service which was put up before Hon'ble Administrative Judge, Raebareli through online office note dated 17.09.2021 on which His Lordship has been pleased to pass the following online order dated 17.12.2021:

"The details of the movable properties held by the officer is reflected in column 4 of the above statement. It is also mentioned that the above Jewellery is parental and Streedhan. The officer is required to submit the financial status of her parents who gave her the Streedhan."

The order of the Hon'ble Court had been communicated to the officer concerned vide online dated 04.01.2022.

In the aforesaid reply, the officer concerned has attached "ITRs of her parents" and "PROPERTY STATEMENT TABLEWISE" as attachments dated 15.01.2022, but from perusal of submitted copies of ITRs of her father and mother, in which income is shown as Rs.10,50,834/- and Rs.2,31,300/- only respectively for them, it clearly not complies the aforesaid Hon'ble Court's order.

Accordingly, the officer was again asked vide High Court's online communication dated 28.01.2022 "to submit the financial status of her parents who gave her the Streedhan, as she has mentioned that the jewellery, shown in her property statement is parental and Streedhan and again requested that compliance of Hon'ble Court's order should be done precisely by showing certain related details alongwith supporting papers, if any, i.e., profession, income from profession and financial status of her parents and by establishing co-relation with their earnings which enables them to gift such amount of Gold, Silver, Diamond jewellery as well as Silver utensils to her.

After that, the officer has attached "explanation" and "new chart" in the attachment dated 13.02.2022 and 17.02.2022 in the aforesaid statements which is as follows:

ATALLAHABAD

Explanation regarding financial status of her parents at the time of joining

- 1. Her grandfather late Shri Omprakash Singh was a Zamindar of Village Sakrauli district Etah. He had a lot of ancestral gold and silver. He was a rich and well to do family.
- 2. Her grandmother Smt. Omvati was an elder daughter of her parents so she had held time to time gold and silver jewellery and land property from her parents.
- 3. Her father Shri K.P.Singh is a development officer in L.I.C. and he is completed near about 30 years service. He had also takes incentive/bonus around 6 lac per annum in spite of salaries.
- 4. Her parents have five buildings (H.N.131 MIG, Shastripuram, H.N.180 MIG Shastripuram, H.N.33/AK40 Radhanagar Balkeshwar, H.N.27 Jones Lines Jeewani mandi and H.N.13-14 Dayalbagh) in Agra, rent is also recovered from there.
- 5. Her brother Shri Ajitpal Singh is a govt. medical officer posted at Jasvant Nagar CHC and his wife is a govt. teacher posted at Agra.
- 6. Her younger brother Shri Amarpal Singh is a mechanical engineer served at Tata consultancy company Noida.
- 7. Her uncle Shri Narendrapal Singh has a transport business at Agra and another uncle Shri Dr. S.P.Singh is a professor at St. john's college Agra and his wife is a teacher at St.paul's Convent School Agra and other uncle Shri Yatendrapal Singh is a doctor at private hospital in Delhi.
- 8. Her family is joint family and well to do family. She is an elder daughter in her family thus all the family members have a lot of natural love and affection, her grandfather, grandmother, father and mother gifted her gold and silver ornaments at her birth and birthdays and from time to time on different occasions and rituals, gifted her gold and silver jewellery.
- 9. Her maternal grandfather Shri Hariram Bhadauria is a retired deputy director in medical department of U.P. and now he is running Sowaran Singh Ayurvedic Medical College Gwalior Road Agra.
- 10. She was joined Bihar Judicial service as a civil judge (J.D.) of 2013 batch before joining the U.P.judicial service
- 11. On her selectionin Bihar judicial service as a civil judge her father and mother aith natural love and affection gifted her gold and silver ornaments and again in selection of U.P.Judicial service her father and mother with natural love and affection gifted her gold and silver ornaments.
- 12. During the period of service in Bihar judiciary she had no any other expenses so she had purchased time to time gold and silver jewellery from her salary savings.
- 13. Her grandfather, grandmother and maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother with natural love and affection gave her ancestral gold and silver ornaments for marriage purpose.
- 14. In property statement ID No.1375 column no.2 and 3 by mistake write the husband name and child name and her profession but now it is corrected that she was single at the time of joining in the U.P. Judicial service.

The officer has also attached "new chart" in the attachment dated 13.02.2022 and 17.02.2022 relating to her property held at the time of joining and subsequent increase in her property, as separately ordered in her husband's Property statement Id no. 1591. However, related office notes have also been submitted in respective other Property statement Ids. This office note is submitted as per directions of His Lordship dated 17.12.2021 relating to the details of the movable properties held by the officer is reflected in column 4 of the above statement, according to which the Jewellery is shown as parental and Streedhan and for which the officer is required to submit the financial status of her parents who gave her the Streedhan.

May, therefore, if approved, this report/explanation, in compliance of His Lordship's order relating to property statements at the time of joining into Judicial Service of Smt. Anita Singh, Civil Judge (Senior Division)/ F.T.C. Raebareli be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Siddharth, Administrative Judge, Raebareli for His Lordship's kind perusal and further orders?
