May kindly see the property statement submitted online received from Sri Brahmpal Singh, presently posted as Civil Judge (Senior Div.), Rampur regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) of the officer, concerned, details of income, deductions, savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

In the financial year 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19), his Total income from salary is Rs. 18,44,858/- and total deductions/savings/investments against IT, PPF approx, Insurances (ABSL Wealthsecure LCV Wholelife and SBI Life) and repayment of Car Loan Rs. 6,62,952/- (including enhancement of Rs. 57,153/- in his S.B. A/cs against the balance of the previous year). Thus a sum of Rs. 11,81,906/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of two members in both the financial years.

It is pertinent to mention here that his father and brother is in Government Service and their salary are 4,70,000/- and 3,30,000/- per year respectively.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements online at the time of joining which is also seen online by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, the then Administrative Judge, Hathras Judgeship.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit his property statements for the financial year 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) in its next financial year i.e., 2019-20 upto March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) firstly vide his application dated 08.11.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer and he has not given any reason for delay.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) of Sri Brahmpal Singh, presently posted as Civil Judge (Senior Div.), Rampur, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Deepak Varma, Administrative Judge, Rampur for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
