In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has submitted online his property statement at the time of joining, which has already been processed online before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Agra on old case-id no.2081.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2015-17 (2015-16 & 2016-17) in its next financial year i.e., 2017-18 upto March 2018. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2015-17 (2015-16 & 2016-17) firstly vide online dated 9.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which he has stated that delay caused due to workload and human error. for which officer sincerely apologises for the same.
