May kindly see the property statement submitted online received from Sri Anupam Kumar, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Saharanpur regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court. In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20, Total Gross income is Rs.48,84,438/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, PRAN, Income Tax, LIC, PPF a/c, Insurance policies and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.84,209/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.18,65,526/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.30,18,912/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that officer has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2017-18 which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Shashi Kant Gupta, the then Administrative Judge, Kaushambi in the misc. file of the officer. It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 vide online dated 06.11.2020. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Sri Anupam Kumar, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Saharanpur be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Gupta, Administrative Judge, Saharanpur for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
