May kindly see the online letter dated 22.03.2021 (as online attachment) by which Sri Neeraj Kumar Mahajan, Additional District and Sessions Judge, Hamirpur has submitted his movable and immovable property statements held at the time of joining into U.P. Higher Judicial Service i.e his joining 30.09.2019.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit his property statements held at the time of joining into U.P.Higher Judicial Service on or just after entering into U.P. Higher Judicial Service. He has submitted the aforesaid statements firstly through his letter dated 24.12.2020. As such, there is delay in submitting the aforesaid statements from the part of the officer for which he has stated in his reply dated 20.03.2021 that- "He joined the service in september 2019 and went on field training. After that he was on training in JTRI Lucknow. Due to training no leave was granted. In January 2020 he came on station and shifted his family on station. Later on Lock down started and because of that he could not gather all his relevant paper for property statement and also could not get his bank passbook entried from bank."
