May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Mritunjay Kumar, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ghaziabad regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18, Total income from salary are Rs.8,16,397/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, LIC, PPF a/c, Mutual fund and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.58,897/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.3,67,330/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.4,49,067/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting two members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement at the time of joining into judicial service which has already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajit Kumar, the then Administrative Judge, Ballia in the misc file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 vide online dated 09.03.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial year 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Sri Mritunjay Kumar, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ghaziabad be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vivek Kumar Birla, Administrative Judge, Ghaziabad Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
