May kindly see the property statement submitted online received from Sri Jitendra Kumar Singh, Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20, Total income from salary is Rs.48,88,581/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, SIP, loan, Insurance policies, SIP and the balance of his savings accounts is enhanced for Rs.1,66,534/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.20,64,061/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.28,24,520/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting four members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2017-18 which had already been seen by Hon'ble the Chief Justice .in the misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 vide online dated 09.03.2021. As such, there is no delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Sri Jitendra Kumar Singh, Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surya Prakash Kesarwani, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and order?
