May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Ajai Kumar Dixit, Judicial Member, Commercial Tax Tribunal, Meerut regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

<u>In the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20</u>, Gross income is Rs.68,07,954/-(income from salary is Rs.45,17,433/- & income from maturity amount of FD's Rs.22,90,521/-) and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GPF, PPF, GIS, LIC, Income Tax, Mutual Fund (SIP), FD, repayment of home loan and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also enhanced by Rs.80,466/-this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.45,01,346/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.23,06,608/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of four members for both the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20.

In this connection, it is submitted that officer has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2017-18, which has already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ved Prakash Vaish, the then Administrative Judge, Agra In the Misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 vide online dated 21.08.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer, for which he has not given any reason.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Sri Ajai Kumar Dixit, Judicial Member Commercial Tax Tribunal, Meerut be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Salil Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Meerut Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
