May kindly see the online reply dated 25/03/2023 received from Sri Anant Kumar, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Ghazipur, in compliance of order of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajiv Gupta, the then Administrative Judge, Saharanpur Judgeship in the matter of property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, communicated to the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer had submitted his movable & immovable property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, which was put up before Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Saharanpur through detailed office note dated 22/12/2022, on which His Lordship has been pleased to pass the following order dated 22/03/2023:

“The officer be asked to submit explanation within fortnight regarding delayed submission of property statement.”

The order of the Court had been communicated to the officer concerned on 23/03/2023.

In compliance of the Hon'ble Court's Order, the officer concerned has submitted his reply on dated 25.03.2023 (in his verbatim) as under:

“It is most humbly submitted that I joined the services on 16th November 2019 and I was unaware of the time frame and the directions of the Honourable High Court regarding submission of property statement. The said delay is caused completely due to lack of information and awareness. In future, I'll submit the same within time frame as per the directions of the Honourable High Court.

It is most kindly requested to condone the delay caused in the submission of the property statement. Thank you for your time and consideration.”

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement held at the time of joining into judicial service just after joining into U. P. Judicial Service. His joining date is 16/11/2019. He has submitted the aforesaid statement firstly on 09/12/2021 . As such, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statement from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has given the reason for delay and compliance the Hon'ble Court's order.

May therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial service alongwith the reply/ compliance of Hon'ble Court's order, as desired by the Court in the matter, furnished by Sri Anant Kumar, Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Ghazipur, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Prakash Padia, Administrative Judge, Ghazipur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
