May kindly see the property statement submitted online, received from Smt. Meena Srivastava, Judge, Special Court, CBI, Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20, Total income is Rs.42,19,885/- (income from salary is Rs.41,78,960/- and LIC maturity amount of Rs.30,925/-) and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GPF, GIS, Income Tax, PPF, LIC, Car loan and the balance of her savings bank account(s) is also increased for Rs.12,477/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.17,23,364/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.24,96,521/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of her family consisting four members in whole of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that her husband Sri Prafull Kamal, Additional L.R./Special Secretary Nyay Vibhag Lucknow, Annual Income-Rs. 2436021/-.

In this connection it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her property statements upto the financial year 2017-18 which has already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surya Prakash Kesarwani, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow on old case Id no-358.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. She has submitted movable and immovable property statement for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 firstly vide online dated 05.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, she has stated that during her transfer from Gorakhpur to Lucknow, some of the papers which were required for submitting Property Statement got misplaced. Besides this her family was diagnosed with covid-19, due to the aforesaid reasons she could not submit the same on time.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Smt. Meena Srivastava, Judge, Special Court, CBI, Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
