May kindly see the property statement submitted online dated 08.12.2021 received from Sri Sanjeev Shukla, District & Sessions Judge, Azamgarh regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

In the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20, income from salary is Rs.48,88,236/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, PPF, Mutual Fund, Insurances and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.3,39,989/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.23,56,071/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.25,32,165/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of five members in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that Sri Sanjeev Shukla has already submitted his property statement upto the financial year 2016-18, which had already been seen by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pankaj Naqvi, the then Administrative Judge, Pilibhit on old case-id no.738.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 in its next financial year i.e., 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2018-19 & 2019-20 vide online dated 08.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer stated that due to Corona Outbreak, the necessary data could not be collected for the submission of statement, so he could not submit the same in time. For which, he tenders his unconditional apology for late submission.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Sri Sanjeev Shukla, District & Sessions Judge, Azamgarh be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Jayant Banerji, Administrative Judge, Azamgarh Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
