May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Sharjil Khan, Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Div.)/ACJM, Ghaziabad regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per the statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20), Gross income (from salary & other sources) is Rs. 19,03,562/- and total deductions/savings/ investment against NPS, GIS, Income Tax, LIC and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is also enhanced by Rs.19,127/- in this financial years from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.4,85,028/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.14,18,534/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting three members in the both of the financial year.

It is pertinent to mention here that the officer's wife is advocate and earning 3 lac per annum.

In this connection, it is submitted that the Officer has already submitted his property statement held at the time of entering i.e. of joining into Judicial service and the same has been seen online against Case Id: P00013072021 (Old Case Id:3414) by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) in its next financial year i.e. 2020-21 upto March 2021. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) vide online dated 10.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer, for which the officer verbatim: "The presiding officer has held parent court since joining and due to workload the property statement could not be send on time. I sincerely aplogise for my conduct. I will always send my property statement as per mandate of Hon'ble High Court."

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2018-20 (2018-19 & 2019-20) of Sri Sharjil Khan, Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Div.)/ACJM, Ghaziabad be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Saumitra Dayal Singh, Administrative Judge, Ghaziabad for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
