May kindly see the property statement submitted online received from Sri Sunil Kumar-V, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Meerut regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statements of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) of the officer, concerned, details of income, deductions, savings, investment and expenditure made by him are given below:-

In the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19), his gross income from salary is Rs. 41,82,249/- total deductions/savings/investments against CPF, GIS, Income Tax, Insurances, PPF, repayment of loan, total of which is Rs.22,90,933/-. Thus a balance of Rs. 18,91,316/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of two members in both the financial years. And the balance of his S.B.A/c has reduced for Rs.2,28,320/- this financial years against the balance of previous year's.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements of the financial year 2015-17, which has already been processed before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Salil Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Meerut Judgeship on old case Id no.3809.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit his property statements for the financial year 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) in its next financial year i.e., 2019-20 upto 31st March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) vide his application dated 10.12 2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has stated that due to excess of work and Covid-19 pandemic, the judicial & administrative work was affected and his mother's death after a long illness, he could not send the aforesaid property statements on time, for which he apologizes.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2017-19 (2017-18 & 2018-19) of Sri Sunil Kumar-V, Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Meerut be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Salil Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Meerut for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
