May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Brajesh Mani Tripathi, Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Meerut regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14), Total income from Salary is Rs.21,95,816/- and total deductions/repayment/ savings/ investment against GPF, GIS, LIC, PPF, Income Tax, LIC Policy are Rs.8,69,997/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.13,25,819/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting three members for both the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14). And the balance of his savings bank account(s) is reduced for Rs.43,932/- this financial year from previous year's balance.

It is pertinent to mention here that his father Shri Vashisth Muni Tripathi is a Retired Principal (pensioner), Annual Income- approx Rs.4,50,000/- (Pension and agriculture).

In this connection, it is submitted that the Officer has already submitted his property statements upto the financial year 2010-12 which has already been processed before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Salil Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Meerut on old case id no-4550.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14) in its next financial year i.e., 2014-15 upto March 2015. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14) vide online dated 10.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer. In this regard, he stated that delay is caused in submitting property statement due to unintentional mistake, few personal family problems and Covid-19 Pandemic. Officer most humbly seeks apologizes and also makes sure that property statement will sent timly in future and will not repeat such mistake.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2012-14 (2012-13 & 2013-14) of Sri Brajesh Mani Tripathi, Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Meerut be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Salil Kumar Rai, Administrative Judge, Meerut for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
