May kindly see the property statement submitted through online service by Sri Munna Lal, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pilibhit regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family for the financial years 2017-2019 in the prescribed proforma, to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2017-2019 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

(1) In the financial years 2017-2019, total income is Rs. 20,39,011/- from salary in these years and, total deductions/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, Income Tax and NPS comes to Rs. 3,61,189/-. Thus, a sum of Rs. 16,77,822/- was therefore available with him to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of three members in both the financial years. His savings bank account(s) balance decreased Rs. 11,562/- from previous years balance.

It is also to mention here that his wife Smt. Vandana Verma, who is Commercial Tax Officer, U.P. Government, has also income of Rs. 15,54,026/- as her salary in these financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statement for the financial years 2015-2017, which has been submitted separately before Hon'ble Court for consideration on E service ID no. 4658.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement of the financial years 2017-2019 in its next financial year i.e., 2019-2020 upto March 2020. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2017-2019 vide online service dated 09.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statements from the part of the officer, for which he has submitted that he had not submitted the statement within stipulated time due to busyness in judicial work. He apologize for the inconvenience and will not repeat the same in future.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements of the financial years 2017-2019 of Sri Munna Lal, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pilibhit be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rohit Ranjan Agarwal, Administrative Judge, Pilibhit for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
