May kindly see the property statements online received from Sushri Ruchi Tiwari, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mathura regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below.

(1) In the financial years 2016-18, Total income is Rs.16,18,121/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment (for both the financial years) against GIS, NPS, Income Tax, PPF, paid against Car purchase and Car loan are Rs.5,13,535/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.11,04,586/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of herself in both the financial years. And the balance of her savings bank account(s) has also been reduced for Rs.13,189/- this financial year from previous year's balance.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted her property statement at the time of joining into Judicial Service and of the financial years 2014-16 which had been processed & detailed online notes have been laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Mathura on e-service ID no.P00007782023 and 4747 respectively.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 firstly vide online dated 10.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which she has "humbly prayed that delay in sending the property statement will not be repeated in future. The delay so caused due to workload and due to new entrant in service. She was busy with Training at Lucknow." mention in remark column of movable proforma.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2016-17 & 2017-18 of Sushri Ruchi Tiwari, Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mathura be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajnish Kumar, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
