The movable and immovable property statement for the financial year 2017-18 have been submitted by the Officer vide his online case id no. 507 dated 01.02.2020 which was due to be submitted upto the end of the financial year 2018-19. As such, there is delay in submitting the property statements from the part of the officer and he has apologised for the delay caused.
