May kindly see the online reply dated 29/11/2023 received from Smt. Aditi Jain, Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lalitpur, in compliance of order of Hon'ble Mrs. Justice Sadhna Rani (Thakur), the then Administrative Judge, Maharajganj, in the matter of property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, communicated to the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer had submitted her movable & immovable property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, which was put up before Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Maharajganj through detailed office note dated 17/05/2023, on which Her Lordship has been pleased to pass the following order dated 23/06/2023:

"Officer concerned be asked to mention the reason for not filing the statements earlier."

The order of the Court had been communicated to the officer concerned on 10/07/2023.

In reply/compliance of the Hon'ble Court's Order, the officer concerned has stated that (in her verbatim):

"It is humbly requested that due to first time submission of declaration of assets and lack of experience in service and work this delay is caused by the applicant mistakenly. Therefore, the applicant is further requesting kindly pardon for this delay.

It is respectfully assured that timely compliances would be ensured in future in letter and spirit. It is humbly requested to please accept my property statement by condoning the delay caused."

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit her property statement held at the time of joining the U.P. Judicial Services or just after joining into U.P. Judicial Service. Her joining date is 16/11/2019. She has firstly submitted the aforesaid statement online dated 10/12/2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the aforesaid statement on the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has given the reason for delay and compliance the Hon'ble Court's order.

May therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial service alongwith the reply/ compliance of Hon'ble Court's order, as desired by the Court in the matter, furnished by Smt. Aditi Jain, Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Lalitpur, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mayank Kumar Jain, Administrative Judge, Lalitpur Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and further orders?
