May kindly see the property statement online received from Sri Niraj Kumar Tripathi, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pratapgarh regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by him or any member of his family of the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per the statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by him are given below:

In the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18), Total income from salary is Rs.9,26,528/- and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GIS, Income Tax, NSC and the balance of his savings bank account(s) is enhanced by Rs.1,83,685/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.3,79,063/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.5,47,465/- was available with his to meet out the household expenditure of his family consisting of two members in both of the financial years.

It is pertinent to mention here that his wife Mrs. Madhu Tripathi, profession-teacher (private school), her income is Rs.15,000/- per month.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer has already submitted his property statements of at the time of joining which is already seen online by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rahul Chaturvedi, the then Administrative Judge, Pratapgarh for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders on old case id no-758.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) in its next financial year i.e., 2018-19 upto March 2019. He has submitted movable and immovable property statements of the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) vide online dated 09.12.2021. As, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statements from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer is seeking unconditional apology for not submitting property statement on time. It was not deliberate rather it was done due to the fact that the officer was newly appointed in the service. He shall be vigilant in future in this regard. He also condoned the delay in submitting property statement.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial years 2016-18 (2016-17 & 2017-18) of Sri Niraj Kumar Tripathi, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pratapgarh be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajay Bhanot, Administrative Judge, Pratapgarh for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
