Bhavya Tiwari, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow regarding submission of statement of movable and immovable properties acquired/held by her or any member of her family for the financial year 2015-16 & 2016-17 in the prescribed proforma respectively to this Hon'ble Court for kind perusal and information as required by the Hon'ble Court.

In this connection, it is submitted that as per statement of movable and immovable properties for the financial years 2015-16 & 2016-17 of the officer concerned, details of income, deduction, savings investment and expenditure made by her are given below-

(1) In the financial years 2015-16 & 2016-17, Total Gross income from salary & arrears is Rs.15,35,240/and total deductions/ repayment/ savings/ investment against GIS, Income Tax, NPS, Car loan, LIC policies, NSC, PPF a/c and the balance of her savings bank account(s) is enhanced for Rs.23,187/- this financial year from previous year's balance, total of which is Rs.5,35,966/-. Thus, a sum of Rs.9,99,274/- was therefore available with her to meet out the household expenditure of herself in both the financial years.

In this connection, it is submitted that officer has already submitted her property statement at the time of joining into Judicial Service which had already been laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manoj Kumar Gupta, the then Administrative Judge, Lucknow, in the misc. file of the officer.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit her property statement for the financial years 2015-16 & 2016-17 in its next financial year i.e., 2017-18 upto March 2018. She has submitted movable and immovable property statements for the financial year 2015-17 vide online dated 10.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the same from the part of the officer for which she has stated that "she could not submit it on time due to illness of her father, for that she highly regret. She sincerely apologize for that." mentioned in remark column.

May, therefore, if approved, property statements for the financial year 2015-16 & 2016-17 of Smt. Bhavya Tiwari, Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Mahesh Chandra Tripathi, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
