May kindly see the online reply dated 06/01/2024 received from Sushri Anjali Pandey, Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow, in compliance of order of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Samit Gopal, Administrative Judge, Raebareli Judgeship, in the matter of property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, communicated to the officer.

In this connection, it is submitted that the officer had submitted her movable & immovable property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service, which was put up before Hon'ble the Administrative Judge, Raebareli through detailed office note dated 09/10/2023, on which His Lordship has been pleased to pass the following order dated 05/01/2024:

"There is a delay in filing of the property statement from the date of joining itself. Let the delay be explained."

The order of the Court had been communicated to the officer concerned on 06/01/2024.

In reply/compliance of the Hon'ble Court's Order, the officer concerned has stated that (in her verbatim):

"I apologize for the delay as I was new in service and was not aware about the filing of property statement and how it is done .

Request you to please forgive for my ignorance."

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular letter, the officer has to submit her property statement held at the time of joining the U.P. Judicial Services or just after joining into U.P. Judicial Service. Her joining date is 16/12/2019. She has firstly submitted the aforesaid statement online dated 10/12/2021. As such, there is delay in submitting the aforesaid statement from the part of the officer. In this regard, officer has given the reason for delay and compliance the Hon'ble Court's order.

May therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial service alongwith the reply/ compliance of Hon'ble Court's order, as desired by the Court in the matter, furnished by Sushri Anjali Pandey, the then Addl. Civil Judge (Junior Div.), Rai Bareli presently posted as Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow, be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Kshitij Shailendra, Administrative Judge, Lucknow Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and further orders?
