May kindly see the property statement received online from Sri Santosh Kumar Tripathi, Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Mathura through which he has submitted his movable and immovable property statements held at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial Service. His joining date is 24.03.2021.

It is further submitted that as per policy/Court's Circular Letter, the officer has to submit his property statement held at the time of joining into judicial service just after joining into Judicial Service. He has firstly submitted the aforesaid statement through online dated 15.12.2021. As such, there is delay in submitting aforesaid property statements from the part of the officer. In this regard, the officer has stated in his online reply dated 22.08.2023, that (in his verbatim) *"I joined the services as HJS on 24.03.2021 at the time when the Corona was in peak. My induction training was postponed many times and lasted for about six months. During those days I worked in the Court as PO , but many times offices were open with limited clerks availability. After ending of my induction training at JTRI, lucknow and after I joined the court, I knew about sending property details from administrative office. As soon as I get the information, I submitted the same and the District Judge Sir has also forward my statement on 15.12.2021. Kindly condone the delay, if any in filing."*

May, therefore, if approved, movable & immovable property statement at the time of entering i.e., of joining into U.P. Judicial service of Sri Santosh Kumar Tripathi, Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Mathura be laid before Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sanjay Kumar Singh, Administrative Judge, Mathura Judgeship for His Lordship's kind perusal and orders?
